

Parent Family / Engagement Policy

The faculty, parents, staff, and community members of Kealing Middle School shall develop and agree upon a written policy for parental involvement during the development and review of the campus improvement plan.

- I. The Parental Involvement Policy will be distributed during the first six weeks of the school year.
- II. It will be the responsibility of the school staff to establish a two way communication process with parents and families regarding their children’s academic progress. This should include, but not be limited to: progress reports, report cards, telephone calls, notes, newsletters, etc.
- III. The school will make every effort to communicate with parents in language that is understandable. Communication with parents may include, but not be limited to homework, telephone calls, electronic mail, newsletters, meetings, etc.
- IV. Kealing Middle School will hold an annual meeting during the first six weeks to discuss the Title I school-wide programs.
- V. Parents will be given the opportunity to provide input and make recommendations regarding the Campus Involvement Plan, the Title I program, and the Parent Involvement Policy through the Parent Advisory Council, the CAC or at parent meetings.
- VI. Monthly meetings will be held during the Principal’s Coffee at 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. and PTA at 5:30 p.m.
- VII. During the first six weeks of school, parents will be provided information regarding the school’s curriculum and types of academic assessments used to measure student progress/proficiency levels that students are expected to meet.
- VIII. In order to meet the changing needs of our school, the Parent Involvement Policy will be reviewed/updated during the annual Campus Improvement Plan revision process.
